

Terms and Conditions for 123NET School Connectivity

- Usage at School Premises: The connectivity provided by 123NET is primarily for the use of school staff and pupils on school premises. Schools may allow access to visitors and parents, provided that it does not detract from the primary beneficiaries' usage.
- 2. **Duration of Service:** The connection is provided indefinitely. However, 123NET reserves the right to revise this arrangement and will notify all affected schools in the event of any changes.
- 3. **Cancellation Policy:** Cancellations must be processed at least one month in advance through Clientzone, prior to our billing cycle which commences on the 21st of each month.
- 4. Equipment Provision: 123NET will provide Fibre routers and data under promotional offers or at our discretion. Schools are responsible for any additional hardware/software, including extenders. The installation of these and any necessary infrastructure expansion, such as trenching or extending wifi signals, must be managed and financed by the school.
- 5. **Contact Information Updates:** It is the school's responsibility to inform 123NET of any changes to the contact person's details provided during sign-up. Failure to update these details may lead to communication issues for which 123NET cannot be held liable.
- 6. **Router Delivery Address:** The delivery address for routers must match the school's address, except under circumstances where there is no one available to receive the delivery at the school.
- 7. **Marketing and Promotion:** 123NET seeks a mutual relationship to utilize marketing opportunities at the school at no cost. This includes but is not limited to newsletters, social media, and school events. All marketing activities will be proposed and discussed in advance to ensure alignment with the school's brand and vision.
- 8. **Sponsorship Recognition:** Upon installation of Fibre, 123NET wishes to place signage at the school's front gate to indicate our sponsorship.
- 9. **Online Sign-Up Requirement:** All applications must be completed online at **123NET Free Internet for Schools.**
- 10. **Right to Deny Service**: 123NET reserves the right to deny service if the school is unable to provide necessary registration documents and signed terms and conditions.
